The preceding list of species and their seasonal abundances is the first such list for the Little River Community Trail and is not yet complete. Competent birders are invited to make contributions to help fill out the list. Sightings may be sent to Ron Harrell at 207-338-5127 or rharrell9@gmail.com. Each sighting, especially if it concerns a species new to the list, should be accompanied by information that supports the accuracy of the sighting. Such information should include the date and time of day of the sighting, pertinent field marks, viewing conditions (light, distance, flying, perching, sun angle, etc.), observer's name, observer's experience as a birder, and contact information.
